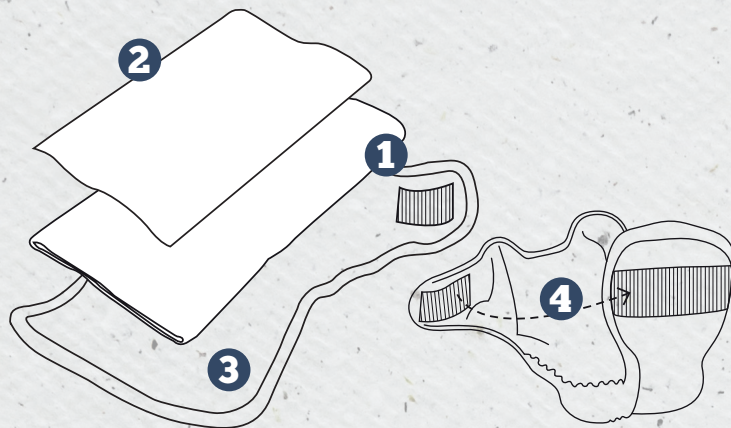
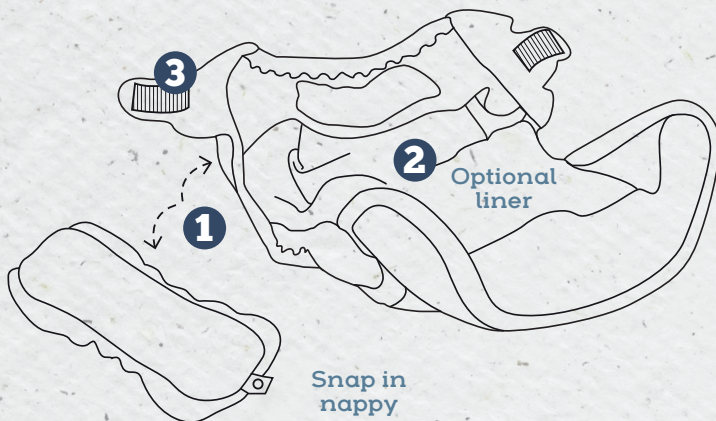


Nappy Guide



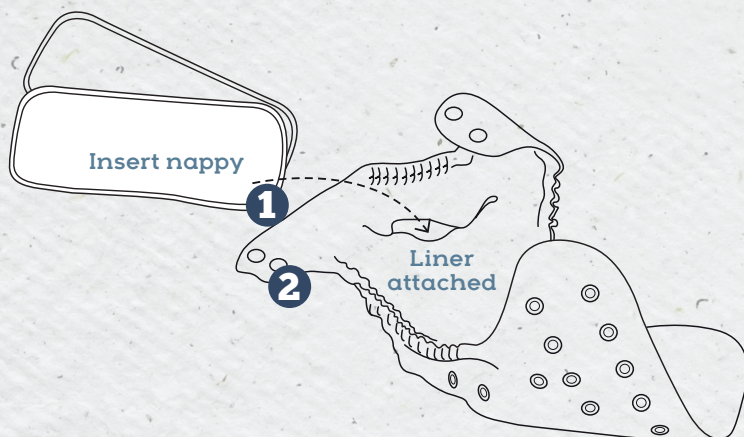
Pre-fold nappies

- ❶ 2-piece system consisting of an absorbent pre-fold and an outer waterproof wrap
- ❷ Liner can be added making 3 piece
- ❸ Good basic cloth nappy
- ❹ Easy to fold
- ★ **Fast drying**
- ★ **Buy more inside 'nappies' and fewer covers/wraps**
- ★ **No need to change the outer wraps unless soiled**
- ★ **Generally cotton nappy with boosters available too**



Pop-in / snap-in

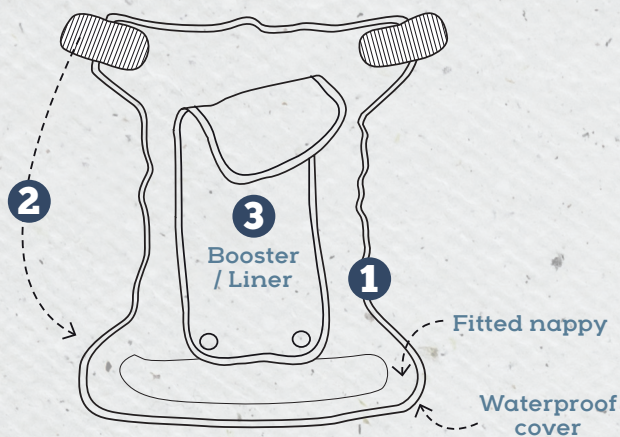
- ❶ 2-piece system consisting of absorbent snap in nappy and an outer waterproof wrap
- ❷ Liner can be added making 3 piece
- ❸ No folding needed - just snap in the nappy
- ★ **Booster layers can be added**
- ★ **No need to change the outer wraps unless soiled**
- ★ **Buy more inside 'nappies' and fewer covers/wraps**
- ★ **Bamboo, microfleece, synthetic inserts plus boosters**



Pocket nappies

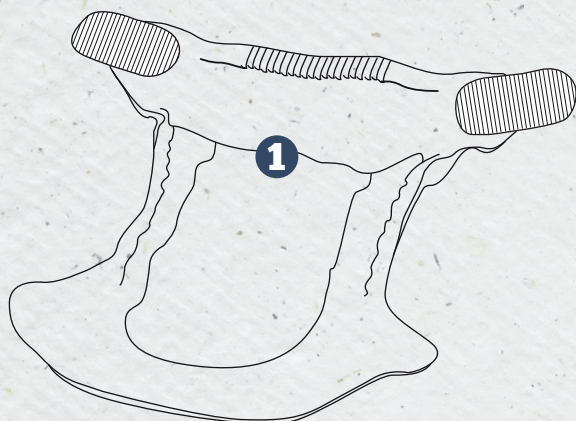
- ❶ 2 piece nappy - waterproof cover with liner attached and pocket nappy to be inserted
- ❷ No folding needed. Only need to pop insert inside nappy after washing
- ★ **Synthetic**
- ★ **Quick drying**
- ★ **Different inserts available**

Nappy Guide



Fitted nappies

- 1 2-piece system - the inside nappy has elastic around waist and legs and the waterproof cover goes over the top fitted nappy and wrap/cover
- 2 No folding required
- 3 Boosters available
- ★ **Double containment**
- ★ **Most absorbent for night time**
- ★ **Contains runny newborn poo well!**



All in one nappies

- 1 1-piece system all components are attached
- ★ **Very convenient - like changing a disposable**
- ★ **Popular with dads and daycares**
- ✗ Can be slow to dry so choose faster drying materials
- ✗ Not absorbent enough for overnight
- ✗ More expensive per nappy as getting both nappy and wrap in one
